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NEW MODULES AND FEATURES IN OPRA 3.4

Marina del Rey, CA. 2001 was a big year for PPS Systems, the developers of the OPRA system. The release of version 3.4 includes a brand new Purchase Order and Event Calendar modules as well as enhanced features and a new look throughout all existing OPRA modules.

The **Calendar Module** allows users, who are granted editing rights, to input their sites or departments events into an enterprise wide Internet based calendar. OPRA then provides your webmaster with a link to special code which allows the public to view the consolidated calendar. Viewing can be selected by date range, site, department or simply all.

“The problem at most districts is that usually one person in a district is charged with keeping a district calendar up to date and often that means many events are never published.”, said Peter Williamson of OPRA. “By allowing the sites to easily enter their own information into the Calendar you distribute the work load and assure that all significant events are published.”

The **Purchase Order Module** was completed and deployed in August. As with other OPRA modules the idea is to eliminate cumbersome paper based business procedures and draw upon the power and ease of use of the Internet. The Purchase Order system supports full multiple approval routing, creating vendors on the fly, estimates and the creation of PO's after a request has been fully approved and priced.
